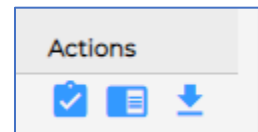

Viewing and downloading portfolio materials for applications

Candidates in the arts, architecture, creative writing, and journalism may have provided portfolio materials to aid in the evaluation of their applications.

To view and download their materials, click the “Read Application” button. This will open the application in a new tab or window in your browser. Click on “Portfolio” to view their materials: the first should display the list of materials the candidate uploaded; the second displays the materials. For each item you wish to download, click on the 3 vertical dots circled in red in the image below to reveal a menu, and download the item.
