

U.S. Scholar Program: Common Terminal Degrees

<u>Award descriptions</u> specify where a Ph.D., other terminal degree, or comparable professional qualifications are required. Please read the award description carefully.

A terminal degree refers to the highest degree awarded in a field. The degree level can vary by academic and professional field, as not all terminal degrees are doctorates. If a terminal degree is required, degree conferment before the fellowship start date is mandatory. (Eligibility)
