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






INTRODUCTION

- Established 1946 to expand and strengthen the relationships between the people of the United States and citizens of the rest of the world
- Sponsored by U.S. Department of State's Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs and administered by the Institute of International Education's Council for International Exchange of Scholars (CIES)



Eligibility for U.S. Scholar Programs

- U.S. citizenship
- > Ph.D. or other terminal degree not required
- Appropriate professional experience and accomplishments
- Additional requirements vary by award
- New policies on previous Fulbright Scholar grants and waiting periods between grants

Taiwan

- Professional Profile:
 - Senior-level university administrators
 - Study abroad advisors
 - At least three years of experience
- Key Highlight: Demonstrate institutional interest in increasing the number of Americans studying in Taiwan
- Deadline: August 1st, 2018
- Grant Dates: March 2019

Japan

- Professional Profile:
 - International education administrators
 - Senior-level university administrators
 - Minimum of five years of full time work experience in the field of international education
- > Key Takeaway:

- Grant Dates: June 2019

Korea

- Professional Profile:
 - International education administrators who deal directly with students on a day-to-day basis, and are actively involved in promoting international education on their campus
 - Minimum of five years of full-time work experience in international education

- Deadline: November 1st, 2018

- Professional Profile:
 - Minimum of five years experience in community college administration

- How the IEA seminar would contribute to the international education goals of your institution?




