#### A BRIEF HISTORY

- Established in 1946 by Congress, Fulbright is the United States government's flagship international educational and cultural exchange program.
- Fulbright is sponsored by the U.S.
   Department of State with funding provided by the U.S. Government and administered by the Institute of International Education.

## Eligibility for U.S. Scholar Program

- U.S. citizenship
- **Degree and experience**, as required by award:
  - Ph.D. or other terminal degree
  - MA and higher education teaching or professional experience
  - Professional and/or artistic experience with substantial accomplishments
  - Teaching experience as required
- Fulbright U.S. Scholar alums are eligible; two year waiting period between end of your last Fulbright U.S. Scholar award and next application

## TRADITIONAL SCHOLAR AWARDS

### **DETAILS**

Open to all disciplines

Held at any university, government agency, or research institution in Canada

\$12,500 for one semester

### **DURATION**

One semester

4 month awards, up to 12 months

Grants begin in September 2025 or January 2026

### **ELIGIBILITY**

Letter of invitation from preferred host is required.

## RESEARCH CHAIR AWARDS

#### **DETAILS**

Field open or various specified disciplines

Pre-arranged affiliations at universities in Canada

\$25,000 for 4 months

### **DURATION**

One semester

4-month awards

Grants begin in September 2025 or January 2026

### **ELIGIBILITY**

Ph.D. holders, or professionals with substantial experience and accomplishments

Letter of invitation required only for field open research chairs



## PIERRE ELLIOT TRUDEAU FOUNDATION FELLOWSHIP



One semester

+8 months of remote collaboration with the PETF to continue through to the following August with occasional travel to Canada for workshops and/or conferences.

September to December 2025

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

Letter of invitation from preferred host is not required.

### **DETAILS**

PETF Scientific Theme

Cohosted by PETF and a partner university in Montreal, Quebec

\$25,000 Additional allowance of up to CA\$15,000



## POSTDOCTORAL RESEARCH AWARD

### **DETAILS**

Indigenous Issues, Northern Issues, Black History

Institutions vary

\$30,000 to \$60,000

### **DURATION**

9 to 24 months

Grants begin in September 2025

### **ELIGIBILITY**

PhD or equivalent terminal degree required

Letter of invitation from preferred host is not required.



## DISTINGUISHED RESEARCH CHAIR AWARD

### **DETAILS**

Arts, Humanities, Social Sciences, Environmental Sciences, Public Affairs

Carleton University

\$50,000

### **DURATION**

8 months

Grants begin in September 2025

### **ELIGIBILITY**

PhD or equivalent terminal degree required

Letter of invitiation from host is not required.



### FULBRIGHT-CARLOS RICO AWARD FOR NORTH AMERICAN STUDIES

### **DETAILS**

Field open

Any university, research institute, or government agency

\$12,500/each semester in Canada and Mexico

### **DURATION**

4-10 months

Time should be distributed equally between Canada & Mexico

Longer-term grants preferred

Grants begin in September 2025

### **ELIGIBILITY**

PhD or equivalent terminal degree required

English and intermediate Spanish

Letters of invitation from hosts are required.



## FULBRIGHT ARCTIC INIATIVE AWARD

### **DETAILS**

Climate Change and Arctic Resources Arctic Security and Governance Mental Health and Well-Being

\$40,000

### **DURATION**

18 months

FAI V in Fall 2027

### **ELIGIBILITY**

Scholars, applied researchers, professionals, and Indigenous and traditional knowledge experts

Letter of invitation from host is required.



## FULBRIGHT GLOBAL SCHOLAR AWARD

#### **DETAILS**

Field open

2-3 countries in at least 2 different world regions

\$3,500/month \$750 book or research

### **DURATION**

3-6 months over one academic year or two consecutive years

Grants begin June 15, 2025 - May 2026

### **ELIGIBILITY**

PhD holders or professionals

Letter of invitation from host is required.









### **Applicants Must:**

- ·Be U.S. citizens
- ·Hold a Ph.D. or equivalent professional/terminal degree unless otherwise specified
- •Professionals and artists should have equivalent experience with recognized professional standing and substantial professional accomplishments

### **Applicants Must Not:**

- ·Hold permanent residency in Canada
- ·Reside in Canada
- ·Have resided abroad for 5 or more consecutive years in the past 6 years
- •Include activities for which a license to practice medicine or nursing is required

Application deadline: September 16, 2024

Alternate award option

Other benefits:

- •Two-day academic and cultural orientation program in Ottawa
- •Opportunity to travel beyond your host city to lecture, attend conferences, or collaborate with colleagues in other regions of Canada •Health benefit plan


























### **Application Components**

### **Requirements:**

- Application Form
- Project Statement
- Curriculum Vitae or Resume
- 2 Letters of Recommendation
- Language Proficiency Report (if required)
- Letter of Invitation (if required)

### **Supplemental Materials:**

- Course outlines or syllabi (for teaching)
- Reference list (for research)
- Portfolio submissions (for artists, architects, and journalists)







### Tips for a strong application:



Before you start, **read your award's description carefully** to
ensure you meet all requirements
and your proposed project is
possible.



Start application and enter referees' information as soon as possible.



**Take advantage of IIE resources**, including webinars, office hours and application guidance on our website.







### **Application Cycle**

The 2025-26 Fulbright U.S. Scholar Competition: Now Open!

FEBRUARY	Competition Opens
SEPTEMBER 16	Application Deadline
SEPTEMBER	Program staff conducts technical reviews for completeness
OCTOBER – NOVEMBER	U.S. peer review
NOVEMBER – JANUARY	Applicants notified of status. Recommended applications are sent to host countries and to the Fulbright Foreign Scholarship Board.
JANUARY – JUNE	Final decisions are made
JUNE – ONWARD	Participants prepare for departure
