A Brief History

- Established in 1946 by Congress, Fulbright is the United States government's flagship international educational and cultural exchange program.
- Fulbright is sponsored by the U.S.
 Department of State with funding provided by the U.S. Government and administered by the Institute of International Education.







Diversity & Inclusion

Fulbright strives to ensure that it reflects the diversity of U.S. society and societies abroad. We encourage the involvement of people from traditionally underrepresented audiences in all our grants, programs and other initiatives.

Opportunities are open to people regardless of their race, color, national origin, sex, age, religion, geographic location, socioeconomic status, disability, sexual orientation or gender identity.









Fulbright by the Numbers



The Fulbright Program funds over 8,000 awards annually:

- 900 U.S. scholars and administrators
- 900 visiting scholars
- 2,200 U.S. students
- 4,000 foreign students
- 400+ language teaching assistants

Approximately 400,000 "Fulbrighters" have participated in the program since its inception in 1946.







Why Fulbright?

Fulbright is transformational.

- Foster relationships that are real and lasting
- Expand your publishing network
- Become more multicultural in the classroom
- Serve as an ambassador for international exchange
- Gain the professional recognition as being identified as a "Fulbright Scholar"
- Join a vibrant alumni network

Fulbright is family-friendly.

- Approximately 60% of our awards provide dependent support
- Many Fulbright dependents go on to have international careers

Fulbright is supportive.

- 70% of applicants engage with IIE staff
- Continued support while in country from IIE and host country staff
- Access to Fulbright alumni as a resource







Eligibility for U.S. Scholar Program



- U.S. citizenship
- Degree and experience, as required by award:
 - Ph.D. or other terminal degree
 - MA and higher education teaching or professional experience
 - Professional and/or artistic experience with substantial accomplishments
 - Teaching experience as required
- Compliance with <u>policies</u> on previous Fulbright
 Scholar awards and waiting periods between grants

- Flex option offered
- Open to all level of scholars
- Letter of invitation preferred
- Anthropology, Archeology, Arts,
 Biology, Communication,
 Environmental Sciences: Earth, Life,
 and Human Sciences, Geology,
 Museum Studies, Paleontology







Fulbright-University of Applied Sciences Burgenland Visiting Professor

- Four months teaching/research
- Open to all level of Scholars
- Letter of invitation is optional
- Architecture, Biology,
 Chemistry, Engineering,
 Environmental Sciences, and
 Physics









Fulbright-Alpen-Adria-Universität Klagenfurt Visiting Professor



- Four months research/teaching
- Mid career and senior Scholars
- Letter of invitation is optional
- Communication, Computer
 Science, Economics, Education,
 Environmental Sciences,
 Geography, IT, Linguistics,
 Philosophy, Public Admin,
 Sociology







Fulbright-Botstiber Visiting Professor of Austrian-American Studies



- Four months research, teaching, professional project
- Artists, Professionals, Early Career, Mid career and Senior Scholars
- Letter of invitation is preferred
- American Studies, Non-U.S. Area Studies, Art History, Arts, Economics,
 Education, Film/Cinema Studies, American and Non-U.S. History, Journalism,
 Law, Literature (Both U.S. and Non-U.S.), Music, Philosophy, Political Science
 and Sociology







Fulbright-Kathryn and Craig Hall Distinguished Chair for Entrepreneurship in Central Europe



- Four months research/teaching, or teaching and research only
- Open to senior Scholars
- Letter of invitation is optional
- Business, Economics,
 Marketing, Public
 Administration







Application Components

Requirements:

- Application Form
- Project Statement
- Curriculum Vitae or Resume
- 2 Letters of Recommendation
- Language Proficiency Report (if required)
- Letter of Invitation (if required)

Supplemental Materials:

- Course outlines or syllabi (for teaching)
- Select bibliography (for research)
- Portfolio submissions (for artists, architects, and journalists)







Tips to submit a strong application:

- Before you start, read your award's description carefully to ensure you meet all requirements and your proposed project is possible.
- Start your application and enter your recommenders' information as soon as possible. You can always save and return to it.
- Take advantage of IIE resources, including webinars, office hours and pointed application guidance on our website.

Remember: You can only apply to one award!

FEBRUARY Catalog of Awards Opens

SEPTEMBER 15 Application Deadline

SEPTEMBER Program staff conducts technical reviews for completeness

OCTOBER – U.S. peer review

Applicants notified of status. Recommended applications are sent to host countries and to the Fulbright Foreign Scholarship Board.

JANUARY – JUNE Final decisions are made

JUNE – ONWARD Participants prepare for departure
