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

- Established 1946 to expand and strengthen the relationships between the people of the United States and citizens of the rest of the world
- Sponsored by U.S. Department of State's Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs and administered by the Institute of International Education's Council for International Exchange of Scholars (CIES)



Eligibility for U.S. Scholar Programs

- U.S. citizenship
- Ph.D. or other terminal degree not required
- Appropriate professional experience and accomplishments
- Additional requirements vary by award
- New policies on previous Fulbright Scholar grants and waiting periods between grants

 - "prepare U.S. and Russian institutions to internationalize their campuses, broaden the scope of their programs and provide mobility opportunities"

- Award specific requirements!



Education collaboration as a means for diplomacy with Russia









- Why I chose Russia
- Application timeline, process, selection
 - Application
 - 1st round review
 - 2nd round review
 - Selection and award
 - Background check, security clearance, medical clearance
 - Travel









- Our schedule
 - 14 consecutive days of meetings/presentation
 - 4 cities (plane, train, bus)
 - Kazan
 - Innopolis
 - Yoshkar-Ola
 - Moscow
 - Cheboksary (cancelled before start-date)
 - 10+ different colleges or HEIs















- Lessons learned
 - It took 12 days and numerous conversations to gain a comprehensive view of the education system
 - Size and diversity of the country
 - Russian: ethnicity vs. citizenship
 - "Students studying in Russia" vs. "Russian students"
 - 12 hour flight from Vladivostok to Kaliningrad











- Lessons learned continued
 - The most insightful conversations occurred over a meal.
 - The food was abundant and diverse!
