

- Established 1946 to expand and strengthen the relationships between the people of the United States and citizens of the rest of the world
- Sponsored by U.S. Department of State's Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs and administered by the Institute of International Education's Council for International Exchange of Scholars (CIES)



Eligibility for U.S. Scholar Programs

- U.S. citizenship
- Ph.D. or other terminal degree not required
- Appropriate professional experience and accomplishments
- Additional requirements vary by award
- New policies on previous Fulbright Scholar grants and waiting periods between grants

 - Minimum of five years of experience
- Yey Highlight
 - "This award is considered an institutional capacity building grant."
- Deadline: November 1st, 2018
- Grant Dates: June 9-22, 2019

Korea

- Professional Profile
 - International education administrators
 - Affiliated with a two- or four-year college or university or a nonprofit international education exchange organization
 - Minimum of five years of experience
- Key Highlight
 - This program is geared towards international education administrators who deal directly with students on a day-to-day

basis, and are actively involved in promoting international education on their campus."

- Deadline: November 1st, 2018
- Grant Dates: Mid-June 2019

- Award specific requirements!




