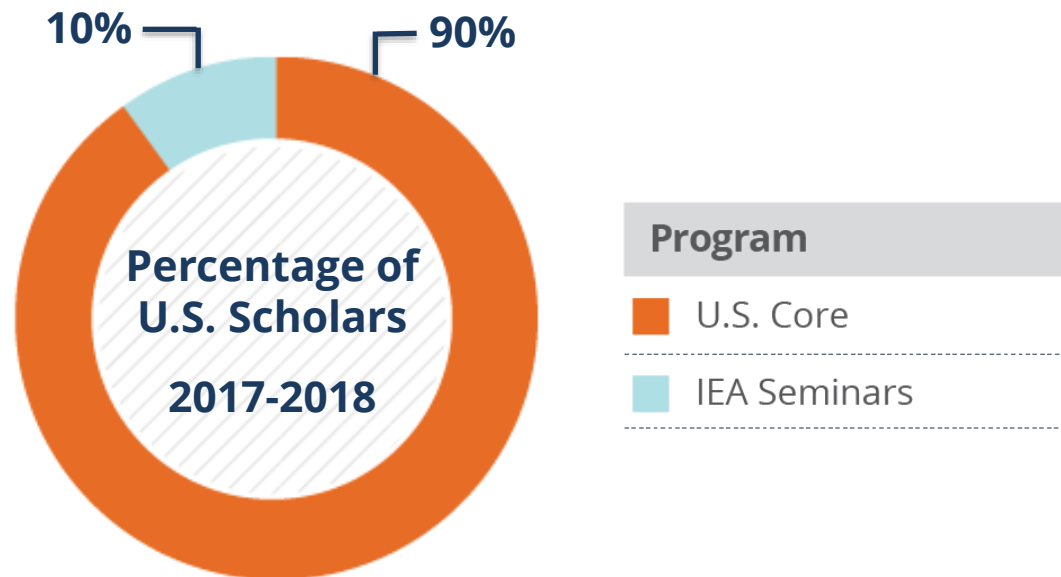

Eligibility for U.S. Scholar Programs

- U.S. citizenship
- Ph.D. or other terminal degree not required
- Appropriate professional experience and accomplishments
- Additional requirements vary by award
- New policies on previous Fulbright Scholar grants and waiting periods between grants

 - Minimum of five years of experience
- Key Highlight
 - “This award is considered an institutional capacity building grant.”
- Deadline: November 1st, 2018
- Grant Dates: June 9-22, 2019

Korea

- Professional Profile
 - International education administrators
 - Affiliated with a two- or four-year college or university or a non-profit international education exchange organization
 - Minimum of five years of experience
- Key Highlight
 - “This program is geared towards international education administrators who deal directly with students on a day-to-day basis, and are actively involved in promoting international education on their campus.”
- Deadline: November 1st, 2018
- Grant Dates: Mid-June 2019

Statement of Intent

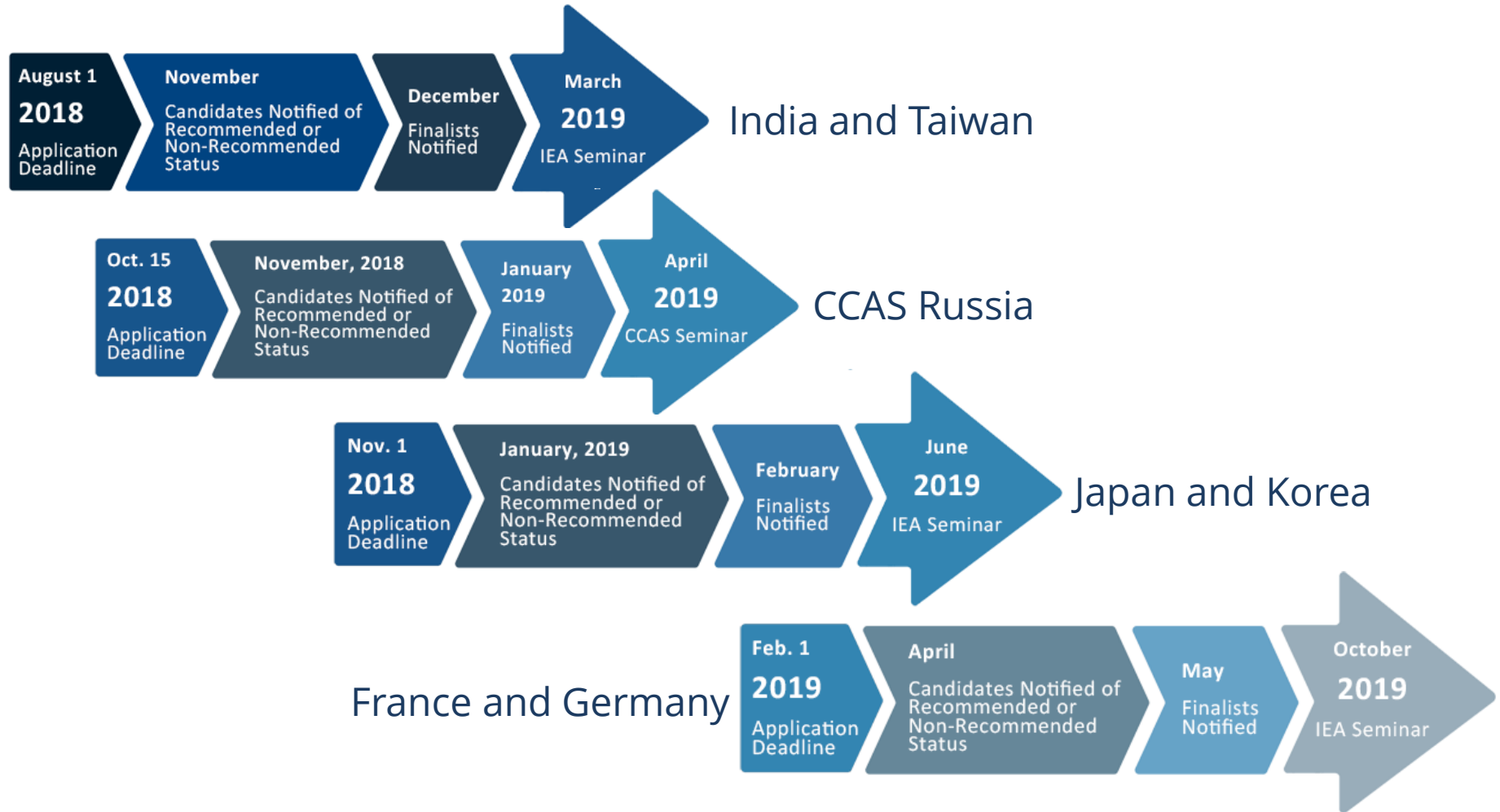
- Your current job responsibilities and how they relate to this grant.
