<p>The semester calendar at my university is different than the one at the school I'm applying to - does Fulbright allow for making accommodations for this?</p>	<p>Thank you for your inquiry! Fundamentally, every award dictates the award length period and award start date. Unfortunately, those parameters are not flexible. I recommend finding a relevant award that works well with your schedule.</p>
<p>Is there any difference in applying for a designated vs. non-designated Fulbright scholar award at an institution in Austria?</p>	<p>You will have to do more legwork for the awards with no associated institution, but you get more flexibility. Austria is great about providing a direct contact for every award that has an institution in its name!</p>
<p>What's the difference between the numbers on the red bubbles and those on the shapes?</p>	<p>The shapes are general, they show existing institutions in Austria. The red bubbles indicate where there are Fulbright scholar awards, which are spread across the Austrian landscape.</p>
<p>Hi, how many awards do you give each year, and how many applications do you receive on average?</p>	<p>Hello! There will be upwards of 26 recipients of awards in Austria this year. However, we cannot reveal rates of competition because the exercise of Fulbright Scholar is rather diplomatic; we arrange these awards with 100+ nations and must give them all equal priority.
