| A few of the awards I looked at indicate that<br>permanent residents are not eligible. What's the<br>definition that the Fulbright uses for 'permanent<br>resident'?  | "Applicants who have resided abroad for five or<br>more consecutive years in the six-year period<br>preceding the application deadline are ineligible.<br>A period of nine months or more during a<br>calendar year constitutes a full year."   |
| How competitive is the flex award v. a single<br>country? How do we find out about the number<br>of past applications v. positions?   | Hello, each award notes how many possible<br>recipients there are. The number of applications<br>per award are not publicly shared.   |
| Are there any awards for less then 3 months.<br>Otherwise, are there any which allow flexibility<br>for taking time every couple of months to go back<br>hope and then return again? Which award enable<br>one to spent time n a few African countries? | Our flex awards are a great option and allow<br>grantees a longer period of time to travel back<br>and forth. Global Scholar awards allow the<br>greatest flexibility in travel.  |
| Is staff available to help match interest/skills of applicant with the most appropriate award(s)  | Yes, staff hosts frequent office hours and are available by email (broken up by region) to discuss options.   |
| I completed a fellowship in August 2022, am I<br>eligible to apply in Sept. 2023 for the 2024-2025<br>cyle?   | If your fellowship ended in 2022, you would need to wait until 2024 to begin another application.   |
| Is it possible to do a project across regions? Say<br>South Korea and Nigeria?  | Yes, this is possible through the Fulbright Global Scholars Awards.   |
| I meant do they need to write a formal letter<br>instead of an exchange of emails?  | Correct.  |
| Hello, You did not indicate countries such as<br>Rwanda. Does this mean there are no awards for<br>this country?  | These are just some highlights, to view all awards<br>offered please review our awards -<br>https://fulbrightscholars.org/awards/search   |
| Can you talk about the funding of the awards?<br>(where it comes from, what it goes towards, etc.)  | This is a federally funded program. Benefits vary<br>by country and type of award. Generally<br>speaking, Fulbright awards are budgeted to cover<br>travel and living costs in-country for the grantee<br>and their accompanying dependents. Check the<br>award description in the Catalog of Awards<br>and/or consult program staff responsible for the<br>particular award you are interested in. For IEA<br>awards, benefits vary by country but generally<br>include round-trip travel, lodging, and a per diem<br>that includes meals. Each award description<br>details these benefits. |
| If we need to set up a meeting to discuss our<br>draft proposal and what programs are best<br>aligned do we use the general email? Or the<br>program lead's contact?  | If you know which region you will be applying to it<br>is best to reach out to that region's lead contact.<br>However, any inquests can be made to<br>scholars@iie.org and those inquests will be<br>directed to the appropriate inbox.   |

Reviewers are looking for<br>"Applicant's project exhibits potential for impact,<br>which is significant, broad, and sustainable in the<br>discipline, at their home institution and |  |

| is a masters or PhD required?  | This depends on the award. Most awards do<br>require a terminal degree or a level of experience.<br>Please review specific award requirements.   |  |
| Where can I find info on the Scholars in Residence program?  | You can find more info here -<br>https://fulbrightscholars.org/sir   |  |
| I appreciate the encouragement to consider a<br>teaching or teaching/research award. I'm sure it<br>varies by country, but can you give a general<br>sense of how many courses a semester<br>Fulbrighters typically teach? | This depends wholly on the reward and the<br>university. This is sometimes predetermined, or it<br>can be negotiated.  |  |
| Any suggestions on making contact with an institution for a letter of invitation?  | Reviewing the award information - there is often<br>host contact information listed. Alumni are also a<br>great resource.  |  |
| Which countries are more accessible for wheelchair users? Disabled applicants?   | Please reach out to the regional lead for more<br>information on this subject -<br>subsaharanafrica@iie.org. There are mobility and<br>accessibility resources available to Fulbright<br>grantees. |  |
| Does the technical review flag prompts that<br>appear to go slightly over the allowed length?<br>Similarly, how big of a problem are slight typos or<br>errors likely introduced from last-minute editing?                 | Errors will be noted and taken into consideration<br>by peer reviewers as these are professional<br>projects. Project feasibility will also be considered<br>at this stage.                        |  |
| Is there an age limit?<br>Where is the list of disciplines? Would Art History<br>be Liberal Arts?  | There is no age limit.<br>This can be explored in our catalogue of awards.<br>https://fulbrightscholars.org/awards/search  |  |
