

IIE GRANT PAYMENT DEPOSITS

Payments of grant funds to Fulbright visiting scholars must be made to the grantee in U.S. dollars in the United States. In the event a grantee is unable to register for Zelle (IIePay), deposits will be made by IIE via Automated Clearing House (ACH) to the checking account you designate. Minor discrepancies and/or incomplete information will cause a delay or failure of payment.

- 2. Include with this completed form a voided check confirming the account details provided below*
- 3. Return the completed form to your IIE Program Manager via the IIE Portal.
- 4. Retain a copy of this form for your records.
