## Why I Chose to Apply

#### Fulbright Distinguished Awards in Teaching Program

Principally for primary- and secondary-level educators

#### **Fulbright-Hays Awards**

 Faculty research, group projects and seminars in designated social sciences and humanities fields

#### **Fulbright Specialist Program**

 Short term grants that promote linkages between U.S. scholars and professionals and their counterparts at host institutions overseas
