Overview

The Fulbright-Hays Program — a Fulbright
Program funded by a Congressional
appropriation to the United States
Department of Education — awards grants to
individual U.S. P-16 teachers, administrators,
doctoral students, and postdoctoral faculty,
as well as to U.S. institutions and
organizations.

History & Administration

- Created in 1961 by U.S. Congress
- Four Fulbright-Hays Programs with annual competitions
- Emphasis on non-English languages & non-Western
 Area Studies
- Over 15,000 P-16 educators, undergraduate and graduate students supported by Fulbright-Hays grants

- DDRA FY 2023 Application is open and closes April 11th


Program Update:

FULBRIGHT-HAYS DOCTORAL DISSERTATION RESEARCH ABROAD (DDRA)







Provides grants to institutions of higher education (IHE) to fund fellowship awards to doctoral students who conduct research overseas in modern foreign languages and area studies for periods of 6 to 12 months.

DDRA Competitions are hosted annually




FULBRIGHT-HAYS GROUP PROJECTS ABROAD (GPA)

Provides grants to IHE's or non-profit organizations to support overseas projects in training, research, and curriculum development in modern foreign languages and area studies for teachers, students, and faculty engaged in a common endeavor. Projects may include short-term seminars, curriculum development, group research, or advanced intensive language programs.



There are two types of GPA Awards



Short Term

Seminars
Curriculum Development
Group Research

Max Award \$180,000



Long Term

Intensive Language Project

Max Award \$300,000

GPA Competitions are held annually.
