## Strategic Outreach Alliance

### Overview

The Fulbright Scholar Strategic Outreach Alliances is a diverse network of academic and professional associations and organizations who have made a commitment to assist in the promotion of the Fulbright Scholar Program's mission.

The Alliance facilitates the sharing of resources and information between Fulbright and members of critical area studies, professional and disciplinary associations; as well as organizations representing diverse audiences. The model of engagement consists of:



- Designation of Fulbright Scholar Liaison at each association
- Exclusive webinars and presentations that feature tailored content relevant to the audience
- Development of a Strategic Outreach Alliance webpage and digital badge to promote the initiative
- Follow-on activities, such as presentations at annual meetings, messages to association listservs, and advertising in association publications

### Alliance Members



**African Studies Association:** ASA is the flagship membership organization devoted to enhancing the exchange of information about Africa, and encourages the production and dissemination of historical and contemporary knowledge about Africa.

**American Association of Community Colleges:** AACC is the primary advocacy organization for community colleges at the national level and works to inform and affect state policy. As a member of "The Six" presidentially based associations, they collaborate with the higher education community to monitor and influence federal policy.

HBCU FDN also shares information about those programs that support academic functions at institutions of higher education.
