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# **General Information About the Application**

The application is supported by most browsers. We highly recommend that you use a current version of <u>Google Chrome</u>, which supports Windows, Mac, and Linux platforms.

Prior to starting an application, please complete the following steps:

Step 2: Record you user name and password in a safe place

Your email address is your user name. When you create an account for this online application, record your password in a secure place. If necessary, you can reset your password by clicking *Forgot Your Password* on the log-in page.

Step 3: Complete the application

You do not need to complete this application at one time. You can re-enter at any time to edit your application. However, once you SUBMIT your application, you CANNOT make changes to it.

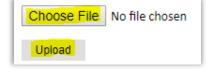

Please describe your experience with this country: Please include if you have visited this country previously, and any communication or interaction with the country such as setting up partnerships, cultural engagement, and

experiences sending/receiving students. (Up to 4,500 characters, including spaces and punctuation.)

- Outcomes and Impact: How would your participation in this IEA seminar contribute to the international education goals of your institution? What is the anticipated impact your participation would have on your institution and/or community? Please be specific and consider outcomes with potential to be broad and sustainable. How would you share what you have learned with your home institution and others? What is the anticipated impact your participation would have on your professional development and career? Registering your recommenders and monitoring the status of receipt

You will be prompted to register your recommenders. Recommenders must be registered before you submit your application. You can track the status of recommendations, send reminders, and add/delete recommenders through this system before <u>and</u> after submission of your application.

- Click Add Recommender and complete the form.
- Click Send to Recommender to generate automatic email to your recommender
  - This will send them an email with instructions on submitting the online recommendation.

After you have registered them, you will have the following options:

• *Edit*: Use this to edit their information if they have not yet started progress on their response. If they have already started their response, you will not be able to edit their information.

Exception: Email address cannot be edited. To update their email address, you will need to exclude and re-add them.
