



## FULBRIGHT U.S. SCHOLAR PROGRAM

### Eligibility and Application Checklist for the 2021-2022 Application

Application: <https://apply.iie.org/fusc2021>

Deadline: **September 15, 2020**

#### Eligibility

- I am a U.S. Citizen.
- I will hold a terminal degree or have at least five years' work experience by 9/15/2020.
- I have *not* lived abroad more than 5 consecutive years in the past 6 years.
- If I had a prior Fulbright Scholar award, it ended before 9/15/2018.

#### Award Requirements

- I meet the degree requirements and candidate profile as stated in the award description.
- I have the relevant discipline expertise as stated in the award description.
- My proposed dates match the award description specifications.
- I meet the language proficiency requirement (if applicable).
- My preferred host institution is appropriate per the award description.
- I have contacted an appropriate host institution to request a letter of invitation (if applicable, *due by 10/15/2020*).

## Application Components

- I registered **two** recommenders\* in the online application:
  - 1) A colleague or supervisor at my current place of employment
  - 2) A colleague within my discipline (inside or outside my place of employment) who knows my work well

\*If applying for a teaching award, make sure one of your recommenders can address your teaching capabilities.

- I confirmed that my two recommenders submitted their letters of recommendation by September 15, 2020.
- I tailored my CV/Resume to the award for which I am applying and stayed within the page limit.
- I uploaded my Project Statement of up to 5 pages.
- I uploaded two to three syllabi/course outlines, up to ten pages, for teaching or teaching/research awards.
- I uploaded a bibliography of up to 3 pages, for research or teaching/research awards.
- I submitted my complete application by September 15, 2020.

## If required or recommended by the award description

- I registered a qualified language evaluator in the online application and confirmed that they uploaded the evaluation report by September 15, 2020.
- I uploaded a Letter of Invitation from an appropriate host institution by **10/15/2020**.
- I uploaded my digital portfolio if applying in the creative/performing arts (maximum 10 images, 15 pages in length, or 30 minutes of audiovisual files).
